

VILLAGE OF CANASTOTA
MINUTES
September 6, 2006

Mayor Rouse called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

PRESENT: Mayor Todd Rouse, Deputy Mayor Scott Rapasadi, Trustees AnnMarie Rossi and Theodore Lumbrazo, Christine Ennis from the Bee-Journal and Residents David Conklin, Margaret Danesi and Dominick Froio

ABSENT: Trustees Chuck Sweeney

Motion by Trustee Rapasadi, seconded by Trustee Rossi, to approve the minutes of the last Board meeting. Passed 4 to 0.

Trustee Charles Sweeney joined the meeting at 7:02 p.m.

Motion by Trustee Rapasadi, seconded by Trustee Lumbrazo, to approve the General Fund Abstract in the amount of \$52,386.51. Passed 5 to 0.

Motion by Trustee Lumbrazo, seconded by Trustee Rossi, to approve the Sewer Fund Abstract in the amount of \$38,686.24. Passed 5 to 0.

Motion by Trustee Lumbrazo, seconded by Trustee Rossi, to authorize Village Historian David Sadler to attend the 2006 Fall Conference at the Inn on the Lake in Canandaigua, New York, at a cost of \$25.00 for registration fees, \$114.00 for one night's lodging, meals and mileage. Passed 5 to 0.

Motion by Trustee Rapasadi, seconded by Trustee Lumbrazo, to authorize the Mayor to execute a Contract with Nextel for cell phone service for the Village in the yearly amount of \$4,055.85. **Discussion:** The Mayor explained that this is the state bid amount. We will have 7 phones that will all carry 400 minutes each and an additional 5 phones that will share those minutes. Passed 5 to 0.

Motion to authorize Greg DiGaspari, James Sullivan, Markus LaBarbera and Christopher Hannan of the Canastota Fire Department to attend the Coordinated Live Fire Attack Hands-on Training at the Concord Hotel in Monticello, New York on October 14 and 15, 2006, at a cost of \$350.00 per person for a total of \$1,400.00. Passed 5 to 0.

She has witnessed illegal activity, been threatened and her property has been stolen and vandalized. Mayor Rouse advised her to contact 911 if her safety is ever threatened. He will speak with Chief Zophy about the situation and believes that the Chief is aware and is watching this situation. Ms. Danesi stated that she would be willing to take an active part in trying to prevent this type of thing from occurring. Mayor Rouse suggested forming a neighborhood watch group in that area.
