Fares: All posted fares are one (1) way

- ❖ Rural (within Madison County) - \$3.00
- ❖ Intra city (within any village/city) - \$1.50
- ❖ Senior (60 years and older) – Half fare
- ❖ Persons with disabilities -- Half fare
- ❖ Youth (age 6-16) -- Half fare
- ❖ Children (5 years & under) -- Free
- ❖ Monthly pass (unlimited rides) -- \$45.00

Times of Service:

Madison Transit System operates Monday through Friday during the times listed on the schedule. MTS does not operate on New Year's Day, Memorial Day, July Fourth, Labor Day, Thanksgiving or Christmas Day.

Other Services:

Additional service connecting Madison County & Oneida & Onondaga County is available by calling our office.

Compliance with ADA:

MTS complies with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Anyone living within $\frac{3}{4}$ mile of a Fixed Route may arrange to have a bus deviate from the Fixed Route to be picked up and/or dropped off at their destination. You **MUST** call the MTS office at least 24 hours in advance for this service. You may call up to a week in advance for reservations. Route deviation fares are twice the Fixed Route fare. Discounts apply.
