

VILLAGE OF CANASTOTA
MINUTES
SPECIAL MEETING
March 31, 2009

Mayor Rouse called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

PRESENT: Mayor Todd Rouse, Deputy Mayor Scott Rapasadi, Trustees AnnMarie Rossi and Charles Sweeney; Village Administrator Larry Carpenter and Margo Frink of the Bee-Journal.

ABSENT: Trustee Theodore Lumbrazo

Clerk/Treasurer Williams presented the Board with the Mayor's Tentative Budget for fiscal year 2009-2010.

Mayor Rouse advised the Board that under the existing Sewer Budget, users pay \$6.50 per thousand gallons of water used for debt and operations and maintenance. The Tentative Budget calls for a rate of \$4.72 per thousand gallons of water used for operations and maintenance and a unit charge of \$98.00 to be placed on the tax bill. In the General Fund Budget, the current tax rate is \$10.89 per thousand dollars of assessed value. The proposed rate in the 2009-2010 General Fund Budget is \$10.65 per thousand dollars of assessed value.

The Mayor also advised that if water consumption is higher than what we believe it is, we can lower the rate next year.

Motion by Trustee Rapasadi, seconded by Trustee Rossi, to adjourn at 4:04 p.m. Passed 4 to 0.
