

VILLAGE OF CANASTOTA
MINUTES
PUBLIC HEARING
April 15, 2014

Mayor DeShaw the Public hearing at 6:30 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

PRESENT: Mayor Carla DeShaw; Deputy Mayor Scott Rapasadi; Trustees Bill Haddad, and Jeffrey Carpenter; Code Enforcement Officer Mike Adsit; Chief Zophy; and Sue Carpenter.

ABSENT: Trustee Rosanne Warner.

Mayor DeShaw advised that the expenditures for the General Fund Tentative Budget are \$2,941,991.40 and the current proposed tax rate is \$9.82, which is the same as last year. The Public hearing is an opportunity to explain the budget and to make comments. The Mayor will continue to verify the budget and she is optimistic that we can reduce the budget - we have to do some more verification of expenses and make sure that the numbers are concrete. Mayor DeShaw stated that in the General Fund, the proposed Expenditures are \$2,941,991.40, the proposed Revenues are \$1,196,187.80 and the proposed Tax Levy is \$1,739,345.60. The Sewer Fund proposed Expenditures and Revenues are \$995,119.41.

Mayor DeShaw asked three (3) times if anyone had questions or comments on the current tentative budget - she received no response.

Motion by Trustee Haddad, seconded by Trustee Carpenter, to close the Public Hearing at 6:35 p.m. Passed 4 to 0.
