HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE DISPOSAL

The Madison County Dept. of Solid Waste funds a **FREE** household hazardous waste collection program for its residents. Residents can dispose up to 20 liquid gallons & 30 solid pounds at no cost.

Limit of 1 visit per household/year.

Appointment required. Please allow 2 - 3 full business days to process your appointment. Same-day appointments will not be allowed.

Accepted Materials: Oil-Based Paints, Pesticides, Automotive Fluids, Cleaning Solvents and more

Reminder: Latex paint is NOT considered household hazardous waste.

To properly dispose of latex paint, remove the lid and add an absorbent such as kitty litter to dry out the mixture. Once dry, it can be thrown in the trash.
