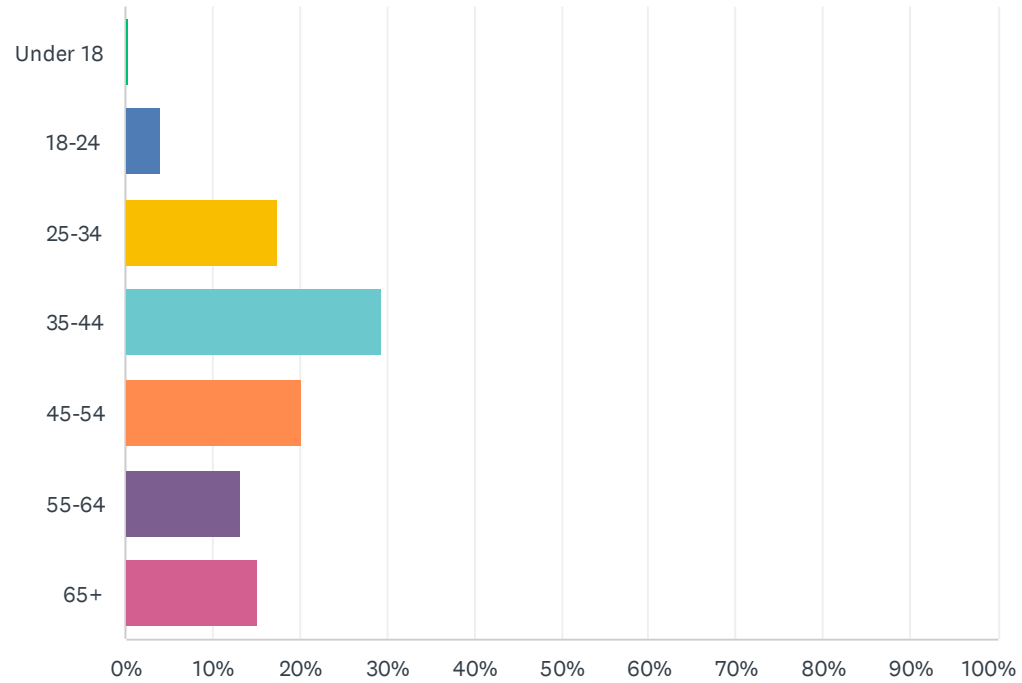

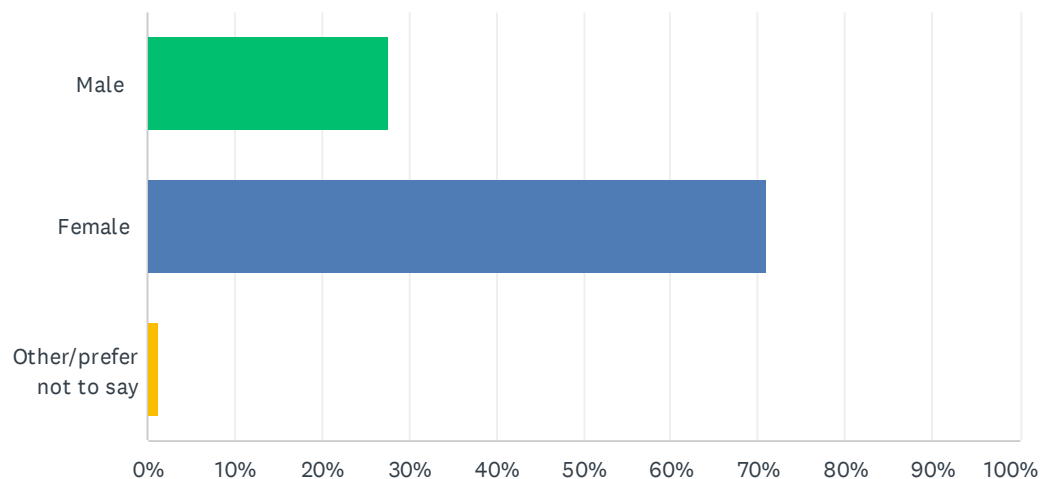

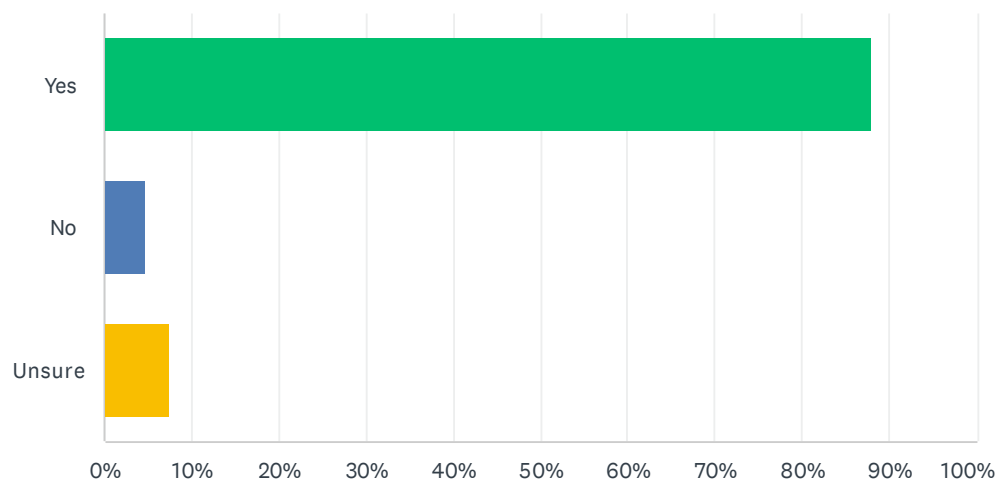

Q6 Are vacant downtown storefronts a concern?

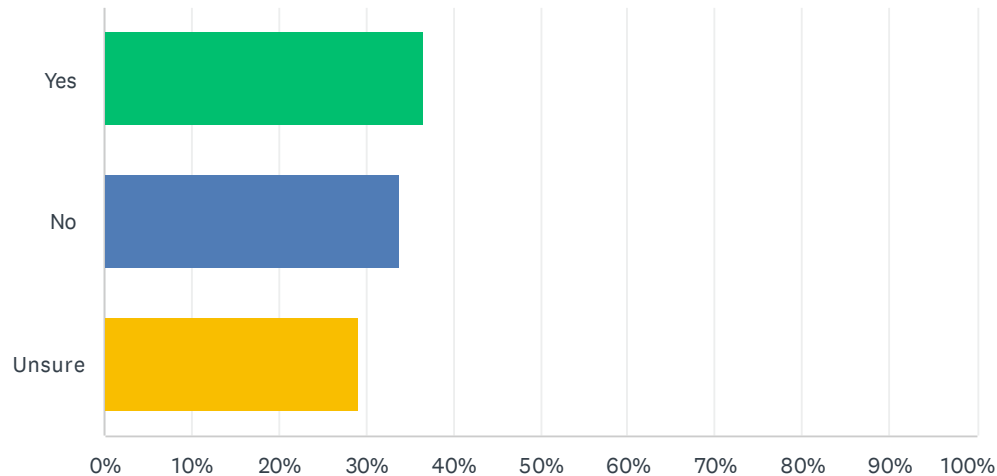

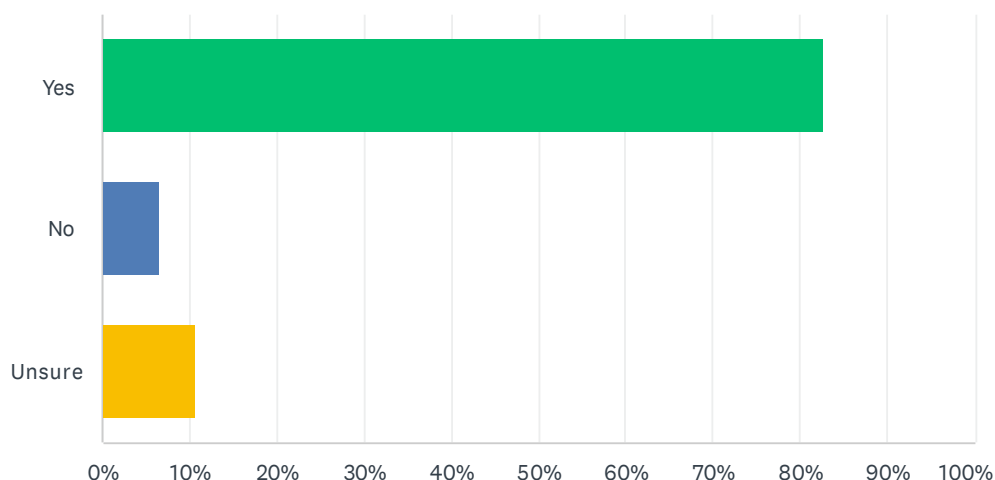

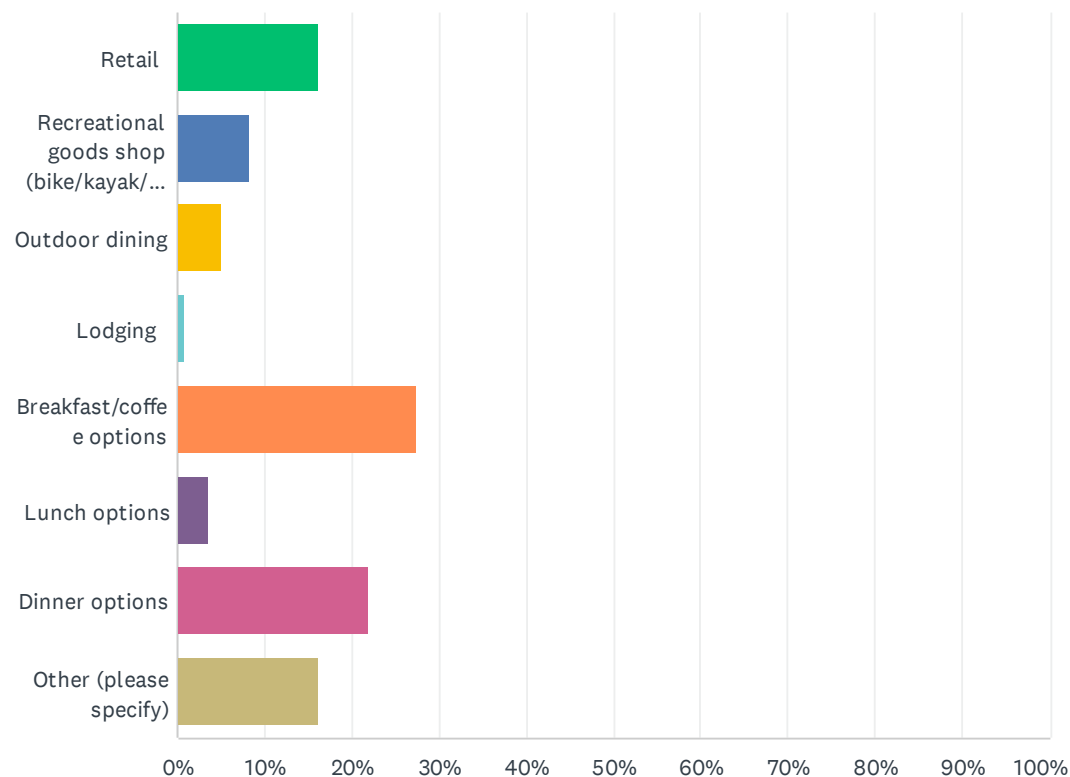

Q15 What recreational services do you use in the Village?

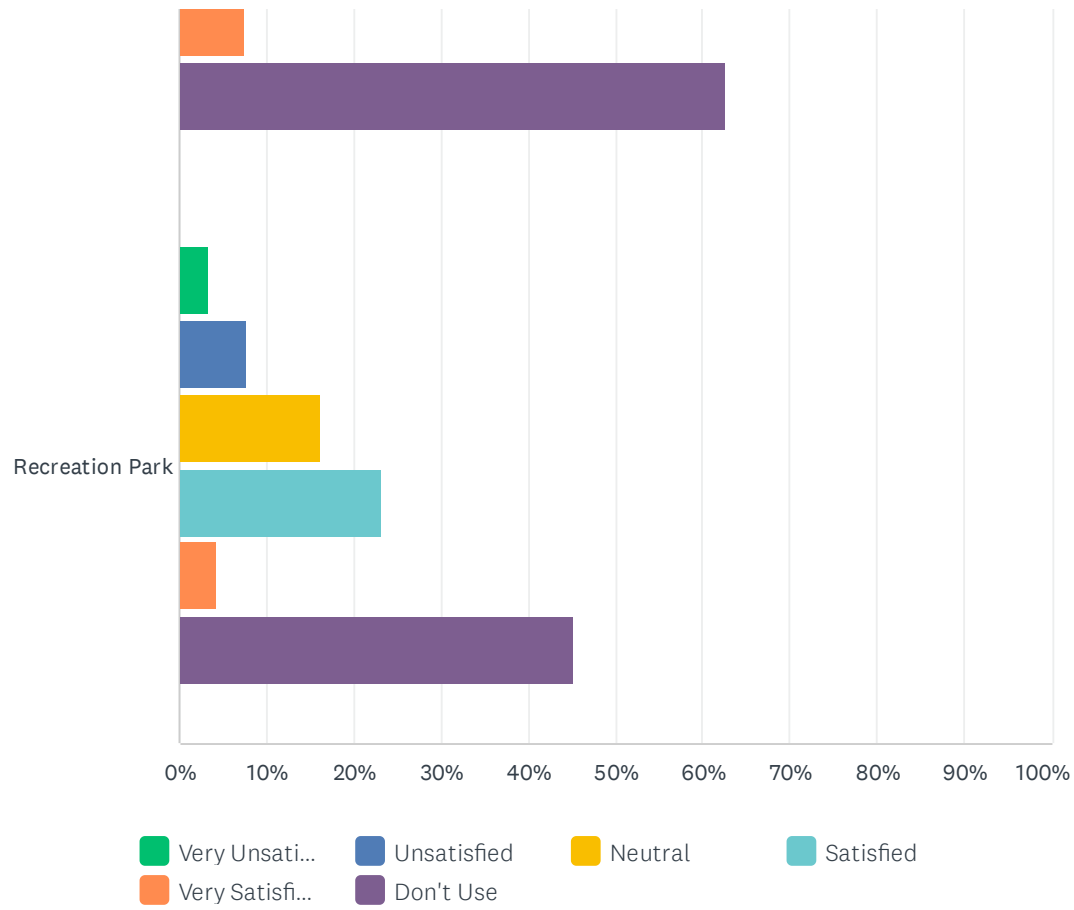

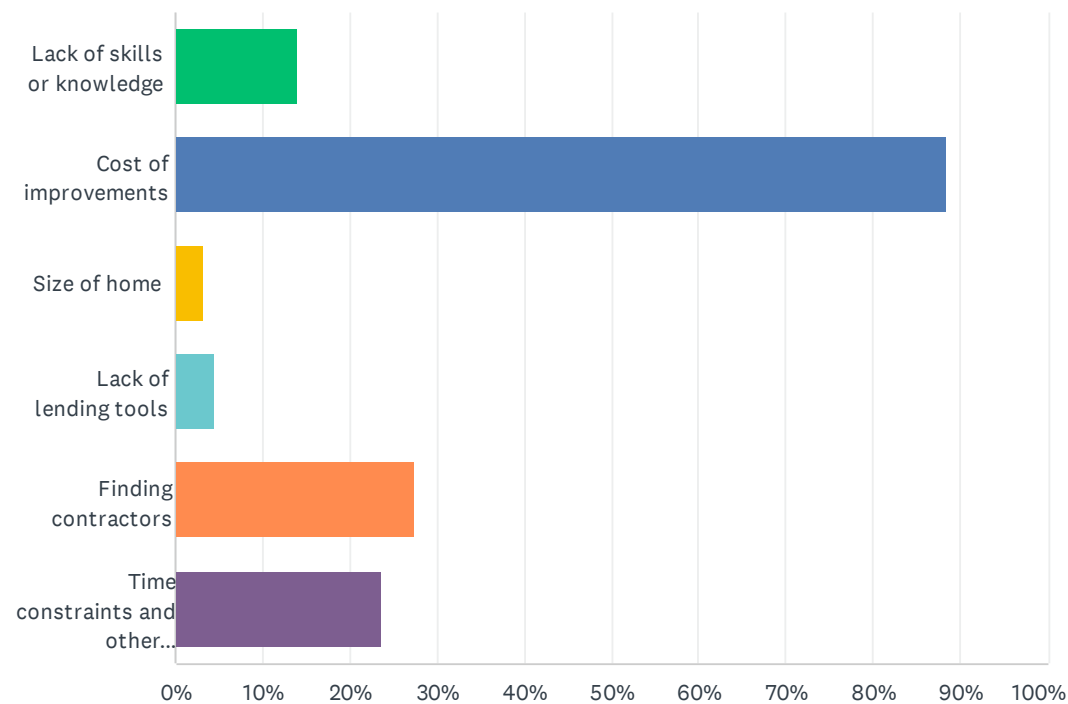

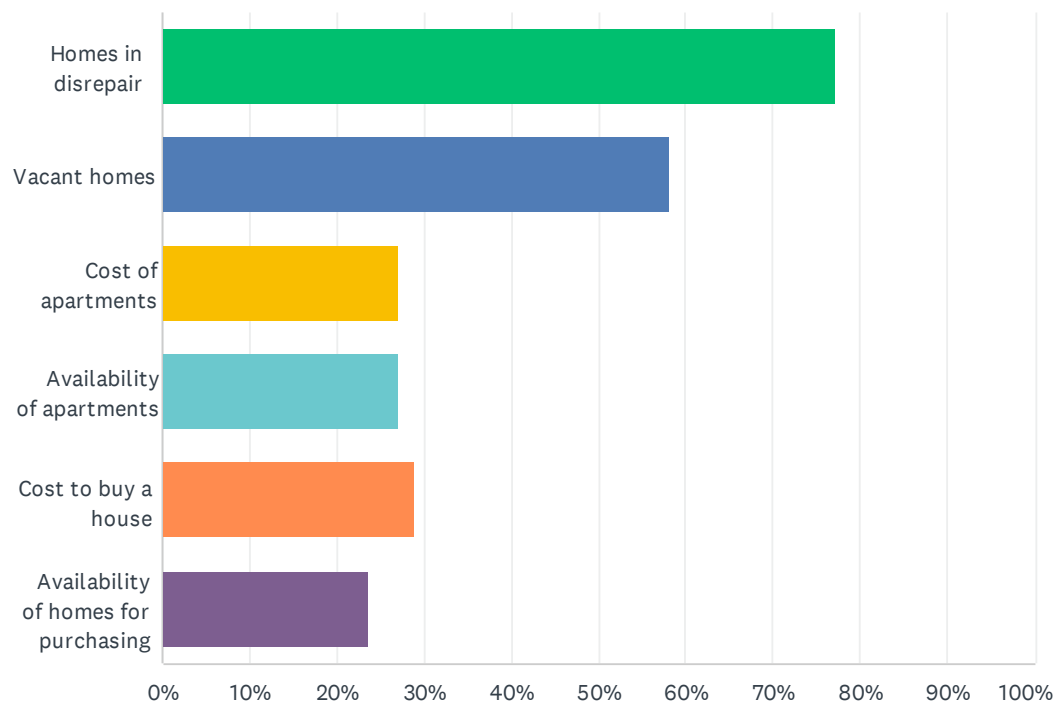

If Canastota expanded its historic district, many more historic homes needing maintenance and repair would be eligible, too. This could help local homeowners tremendously. I strongly encourage the Village to look into a historic resources survey to see where new district boundaries could be. Appendix B: Demographic Analysis

Disclaimer

The most detailed information from the US Census comes from the American Community Survey. Unlike the 10-year decennial survey that accounts for every community member, this particular survey only looks at a sample of the broader town or village population. The sample results identifies the socio-economic characteristics and needs of a community.

A sample that does not account for all residents coupled with a small rural village population can at times create a large margin of error. Therefore, readers of this analysis should understand that the estimates described below may be slightly off.

Unless otherwise specified, the following data is from the 2020 and 2010 5-year US Census American Community Survey.

Population

Canastota's **population in 2020 is 4,556**. According to the decennial census, the Village **lost 248 residents since 2010**, resulting in a -5.2% population change (*Table 1*). Although the population has declined, other villages in Madison County also experienced a negative percent change between 2010 and 2020. When assessing the last 40 years, Canastota's population has waxed and waned and experienced its most significant increase between 2000 and 2010, which is similar to other Madison County municipalities (*Figure 1*).

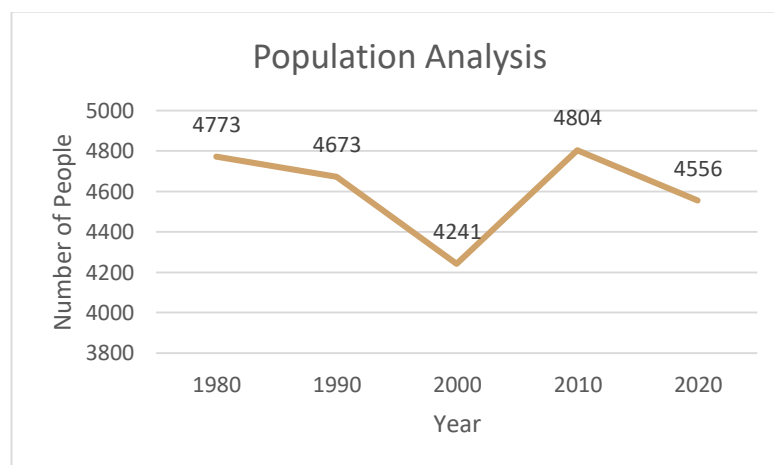

Age and Race

In 2020, the largest age bracket in the Village was 24 and under followed by 25 to 44, 45 to 64, and lastly 65 and over (*Figure 2*). The 24 and under and 25 to 44 age brackets are above average compared to the County, and those 45 to 64 and 65 and over are below the County average (*Figure 3*). As a result, Canastota’s population is younger.

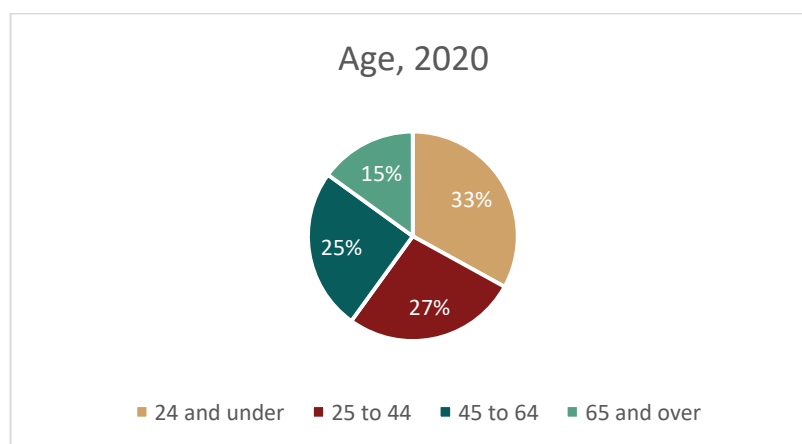

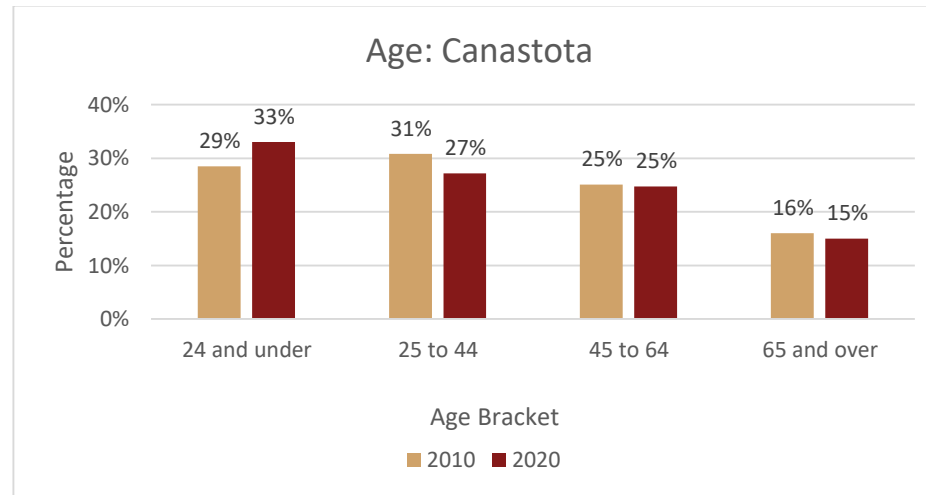

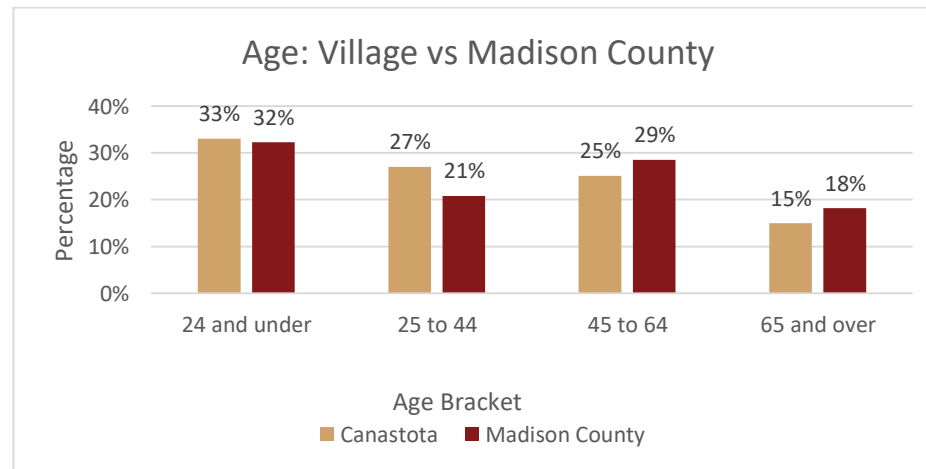

Between 2010 and 2020, the **number of residents age 24 and under increased**, signifying that young families are potentially growing in the Village (4%) (*Figure 3*). The remaining age ranges slightly dropped, with the **largest drop occurring in the 25 to 44 age bracket (3%)**. Although the 25 to 44 age bracket dropped it is still higher than the county average.

The age bracket with the **least number of Canastota residents, regardless of decade, is 65 years and over (Figure 4)**. Further, between 2010 and 2020, the County saw a 4% increase in the senior citizen population, while Canastota saw a 1% drop.

Canastota's **median age is 37.9**, and for comparison, Madison County's is 42.3.

According to the 2020 Decennial census, the majority of the population is White (96%), 2% is African American, and 1% is American Indian.

Education and Income

Assessing educational attainment is important since it correlates with a persons income. In Canastota, the **majority of residents 25 years and older are high school graduates (43%)**, which is higher than in Madison County (**35%**) and New York State (**26%**) (Figure 5a). The **second largest degree type is an associate degree (23%)**, and again, is higher than the Madison County (**15%**), and New York State averages (**9%**). However, the number of residents with a bachelors or graduate degree is below average when compared to the County and State.

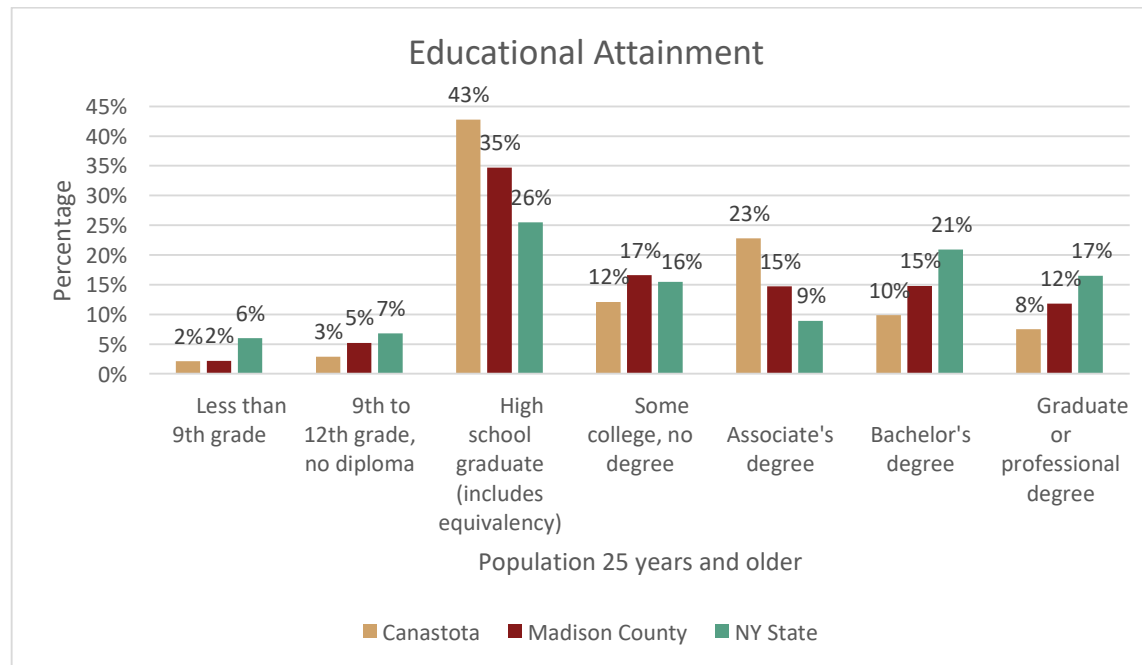

When assessing the correlation between Village residents' educational attainment who are 25 years and older and live below the poverty level, the majority have a high school degree or equivalent, followed by those who do not have a high school degree (*Figure 5b*). Compared to nearby communities, Canastota has the largest number of high school graduates living below the poverty level. Chittenango and Oneida both have a higher percentage of those with some college education and live below poverty, as well as those with an associates or bachelors degree (*Figure 5c*).

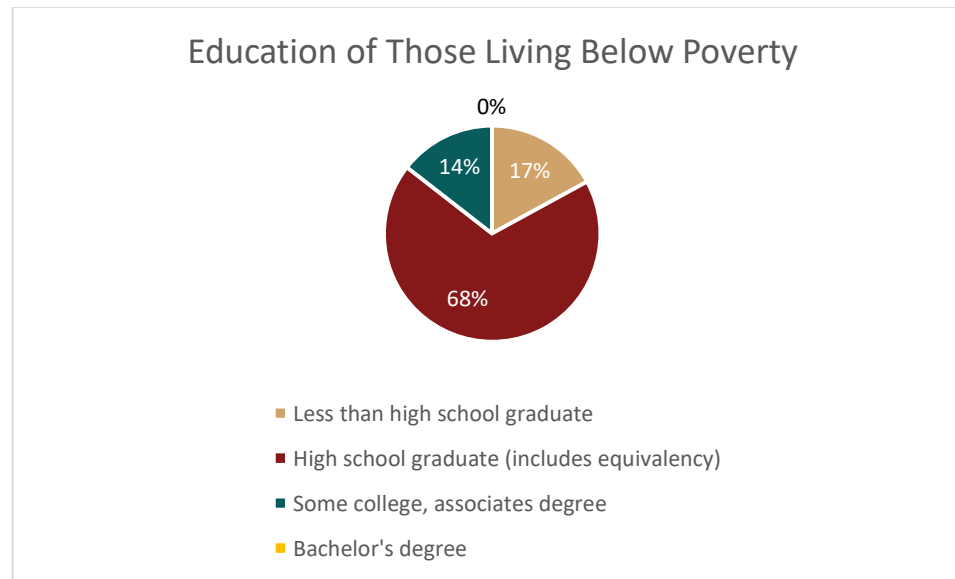

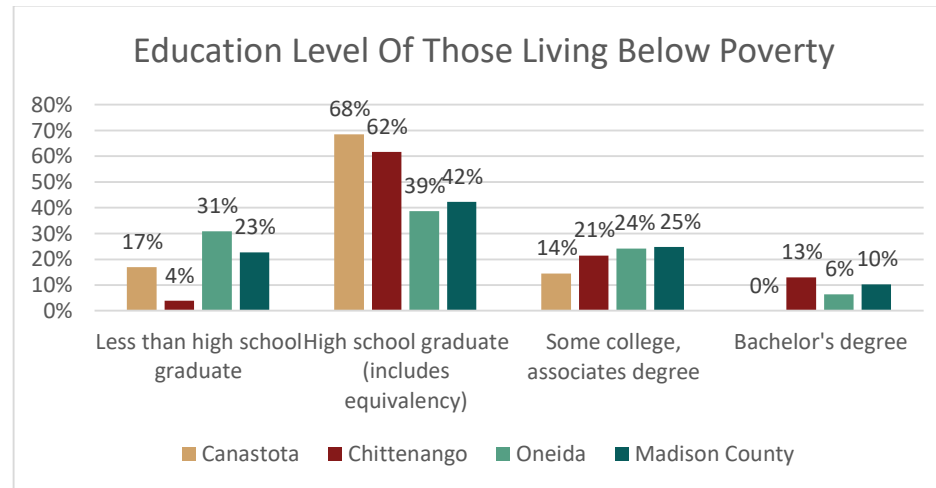

Median household income is a measure that reflects the economic well-being of a community. Almost equal to the Town of Lenox, Canastota's 2020 **median household income was \$59,472** (Figure 6). This figure is below average compared to the County (\$61,176) and State (\$71,117). Surrounding villages such as Wampsville and Chittenango have a higher income while Oneida is lower than the Village.

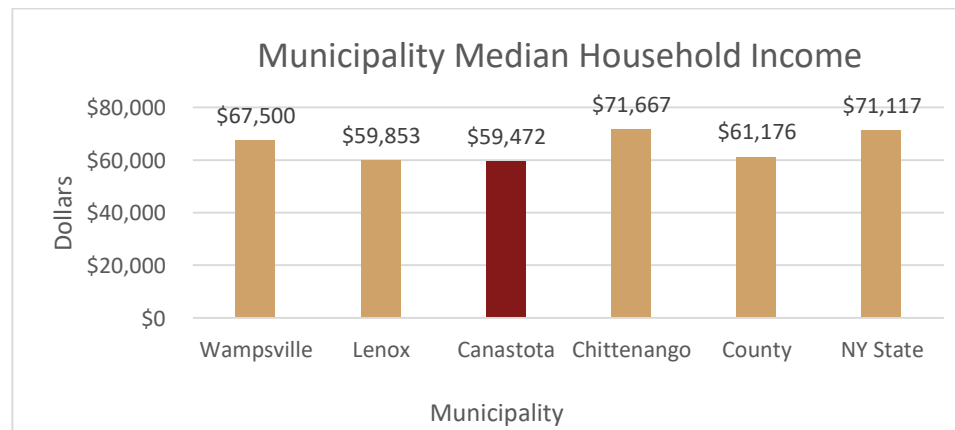

The Village has a variety of household income levels. Most households make an income between **\$50,000- \$74,999 (26%)**, followed by **\$75,000- \$99,999 (13%)** (Figure 7). The number of households making an income between \$50,000-74,999 and \$75,000-99,999 is above average compared to the State. The \$50,000- \$74,999 income bracket is greater than the county average, and the \$75,000-\$99,999 income bracket is equal to the County average. Interestingly there is a dramatic difference between those that make \$35,000-\$49,999 and those that make \$50,000-\$74,999.

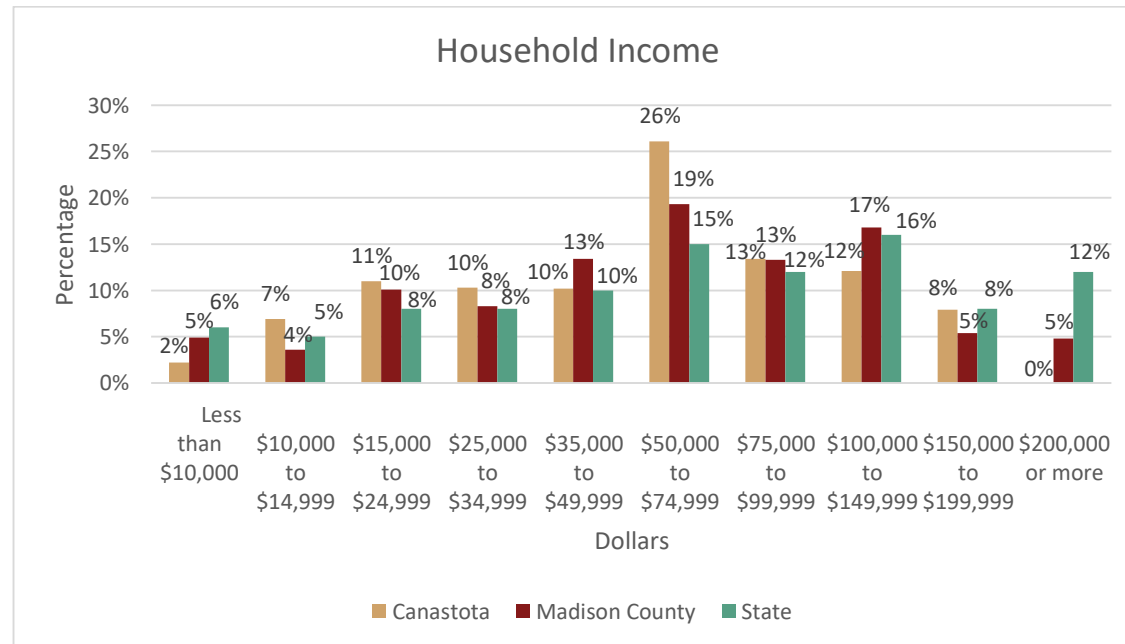

The 2020 Census determined the income range that constitutes the middle class depending on household size, and is highlighted in *Table 2* below. Although Canastota falls below the median income average for the County and State, single-family households are considered middle class. However, when specifically looking at the top two income tiers identified in *Figure 7*, the middle class becomes slightly larger (contingent on household size).

Lastly, according to the 2020 US Census, the **poverty level for a single individual is \$13,171. 10% of individuals 18 years and older** live below the poverty threshold, which is higher than the County average (8%) but not the State (12%) (*Figure 8*).

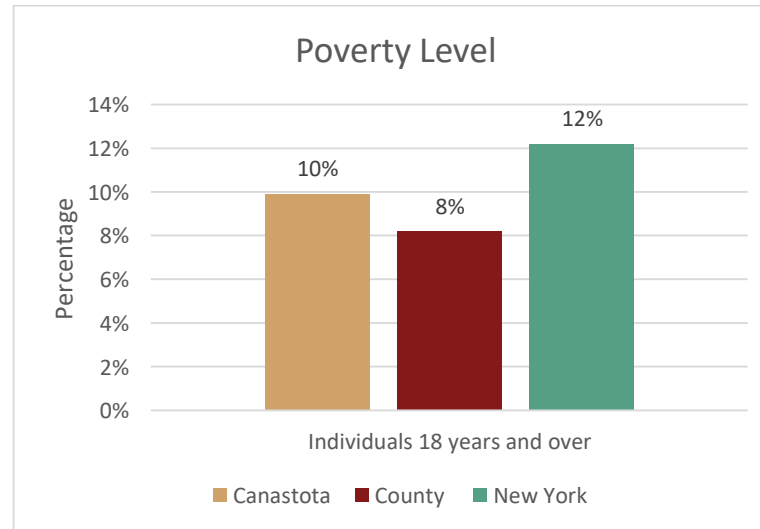

Housing

1,680 housing units were sampled in the 2020 American Community Survey. Of the 1,680 units, 1,032 are owner-occupied (61.4%), and 648 are rented (38.6%). The number of owner-occupied housing units is below Madison County (-17.1%). However, the number of renters in the Village is higher than Madison County (+17.1%) (*Figure 9*). The median housing price is \$132,100.00, and the median gross rent is \$689.00. The Village has

a significant number of homes that are \$100,000-\$199,999, followed by \$50,000-99,999 (*Figure 10*). Since 2010, the number of homes worth \$200,000-299,999 has increased by about 200.

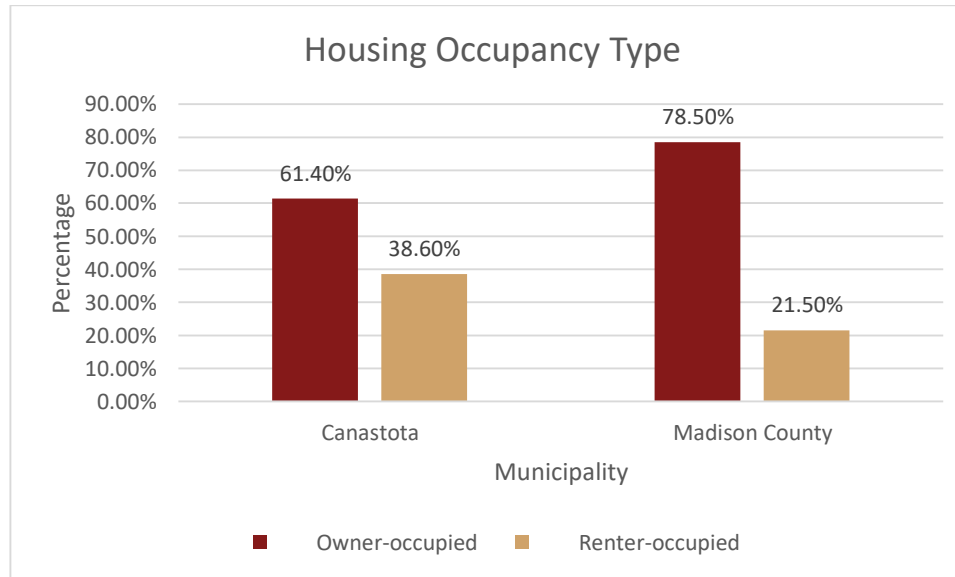

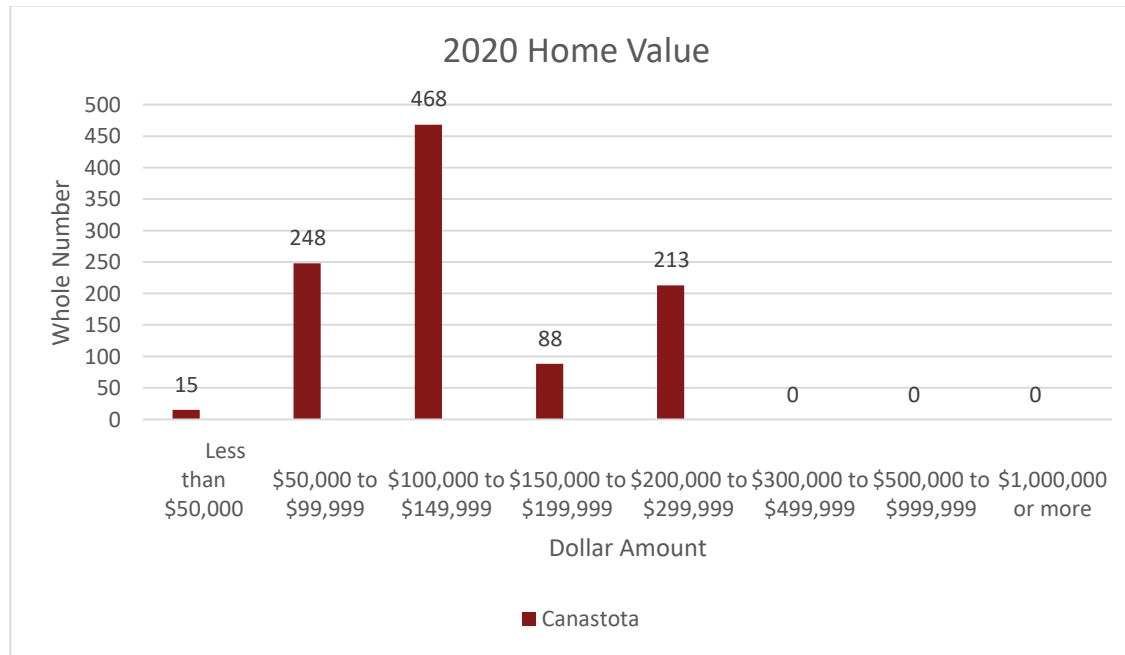

The housing vacancy rate in Canastota is 3.8%, and the rental vacancy rate is 0%. Generally speaking, the low housing vacancy rate indicates that some housing is available on the market, but is limited. A 0% rental vacancy rate indicates strong rental sales and a demand to live in the Village. Given these rates and *potential* future in-migration from the Micron Factory in Clay, NY, housing demand and the pressure to build may increase.

Single-family detached structures are the most common structure in the Village (59%), followed by duplexes (22%) (Figure 11). Comparatively, the percentage of duplexes in the County is 7%. Housing structures are diverse compared to the County and are unique to Canastota. The future Canal Side Pocket Neighborhood will further increase the diversity of housing. Diverse housing types creates access to housing for various income levels and ages.

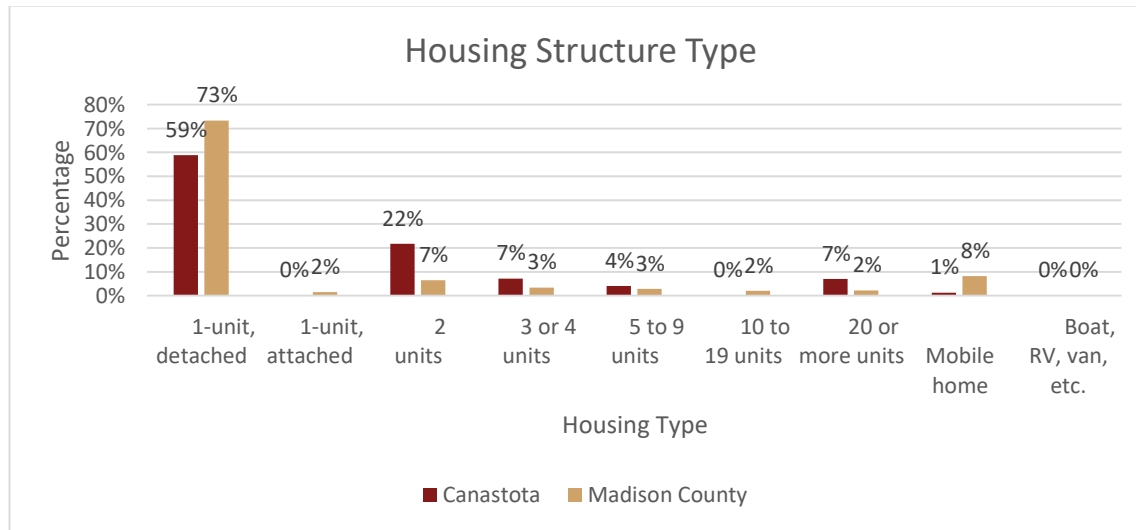

Comparable to Madison County, the Village's housing stock is older (*Figure 12*). Specifically, of the 1,680 housing structures sampled, 42% were built in 1939 or earlier. Further, no housing units were built during 2013 or later, which may correlate with the loss of population. An older housing stock can result in hidden costs associated with owning a home and may create a financial burden. Although limited, the future Canalside Pocket Neighborhood will add to the number of newer homes in the Village core.

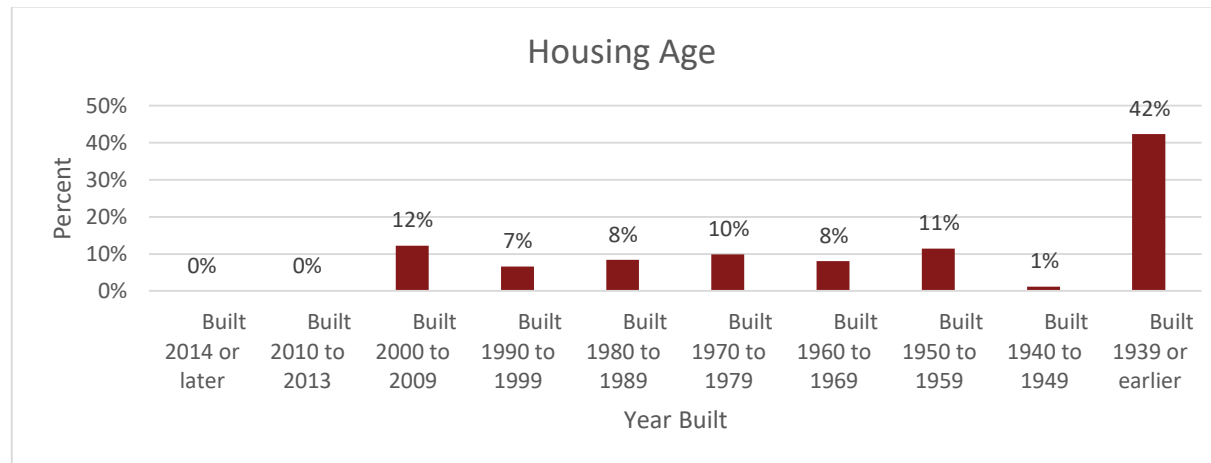

Affordable housing is critical for physical, mental, and financial health and stability. A house or apartment is considered affordable if a mortgage or rent costs less than or equal to 30% of the household's income. 24% of residents sampled spent equal to or more than 30% of their household income on their mortgage. The number of residents unable to afford their mortgages has increased since 2010 (10.3%). Currently, 28% of renters pay equal to or more than 30% of their household income on rent. Affordability for renters has improved since 2010 (51%).

Homes are predominantly heated by utility gas (75%), followed by electricity (12%), and fuel oil/kerosene (11%) (*Table 3*). None of the housing units sampled used wood, coal, or solar energy.

Industry, Occupation, and Commuting

70% of the Village's population is in the labor force and work in numerous industries (*Figure 13*). An industry is defined as the type of activity at a person's place of work. The three most popular industries are "educational services, and health care and social assistance" (27%), followed by "arts, entertainment and recreation, and accommodations, and food services" (13%), and "Finance, insurance, real estate, and rental and leasing" (13%). Comparatively, Madison County's most popular industry that residents work in is "professional, scientific and management, and administrative and waste management services" (29.10%).

8.3% of residents were unemployed in 2020.

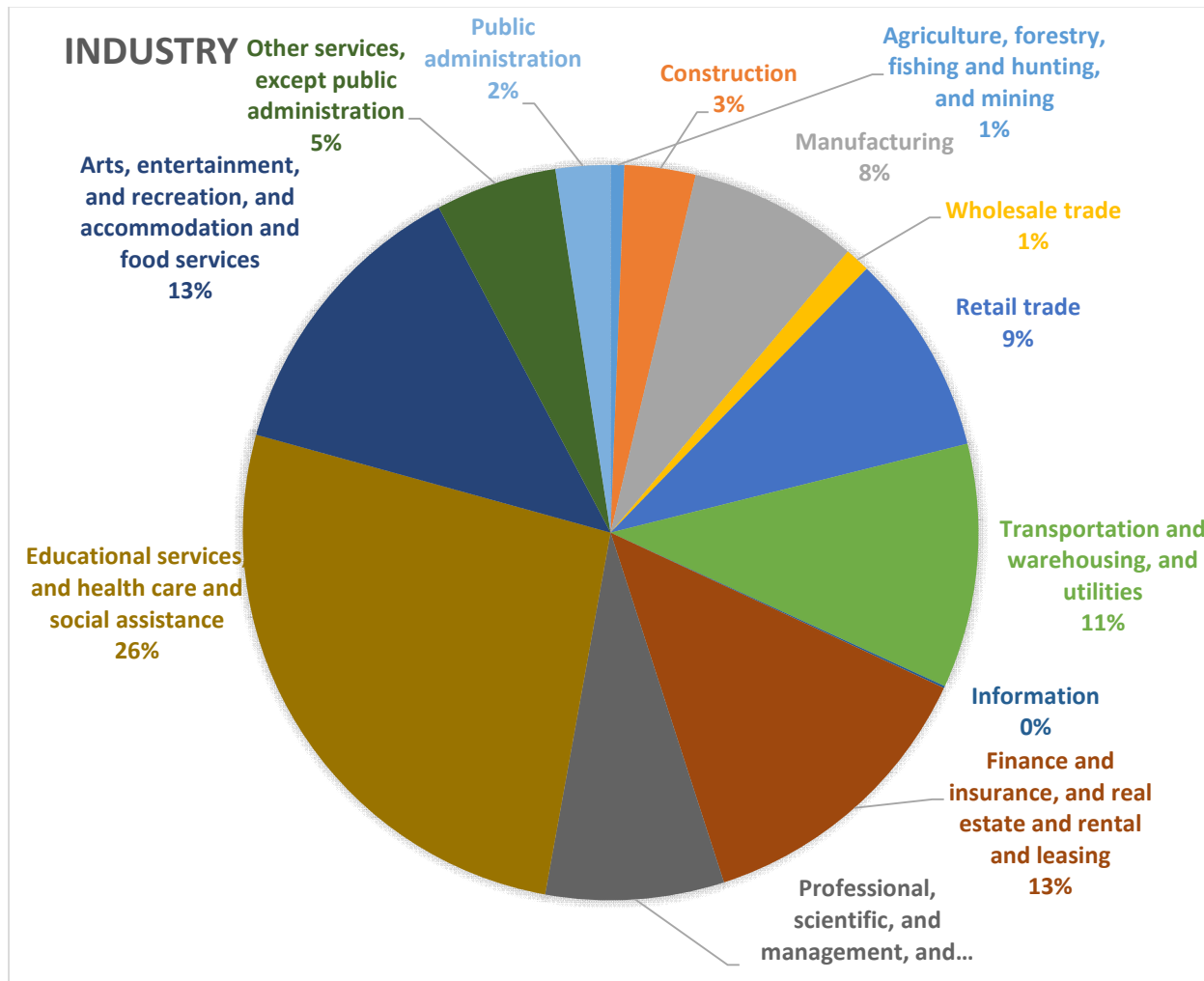

Broadly, occupations in the Village have changed since 2010. A person's occupation is defined as the kind of work a person does to earn a living. "Service occupations" and "production, transportation, and material moving occupations" have increased in size since 2010. Conversely,

“management, business science and art occupations,” sales and office occupations,” and “natural resources, construction, and maintenance occupations” all decreased (*Table 4*).

Similar to Madison County, the majority of residents in the Village drive alone and commute to work (93%). The number of residents working from home has increased by 1% or 47 people since 2010. Based on the sample, 0% -with a margin of error of 1.5%- took public transportation. However, it has been reported by the County's Mobility Manager, -whose primary goal is to improve transportation within the County- that many riders are requesting stops in Canastota.

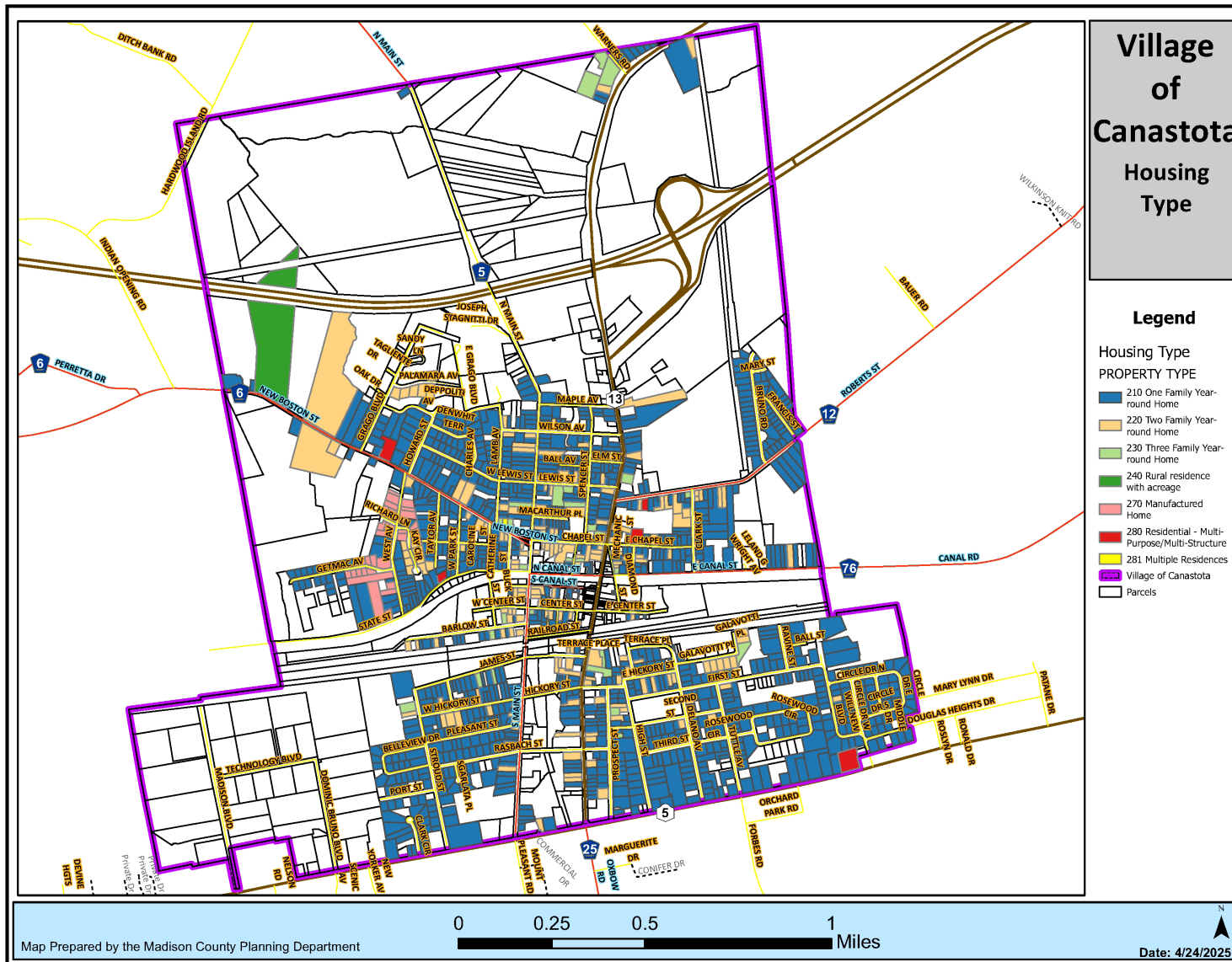

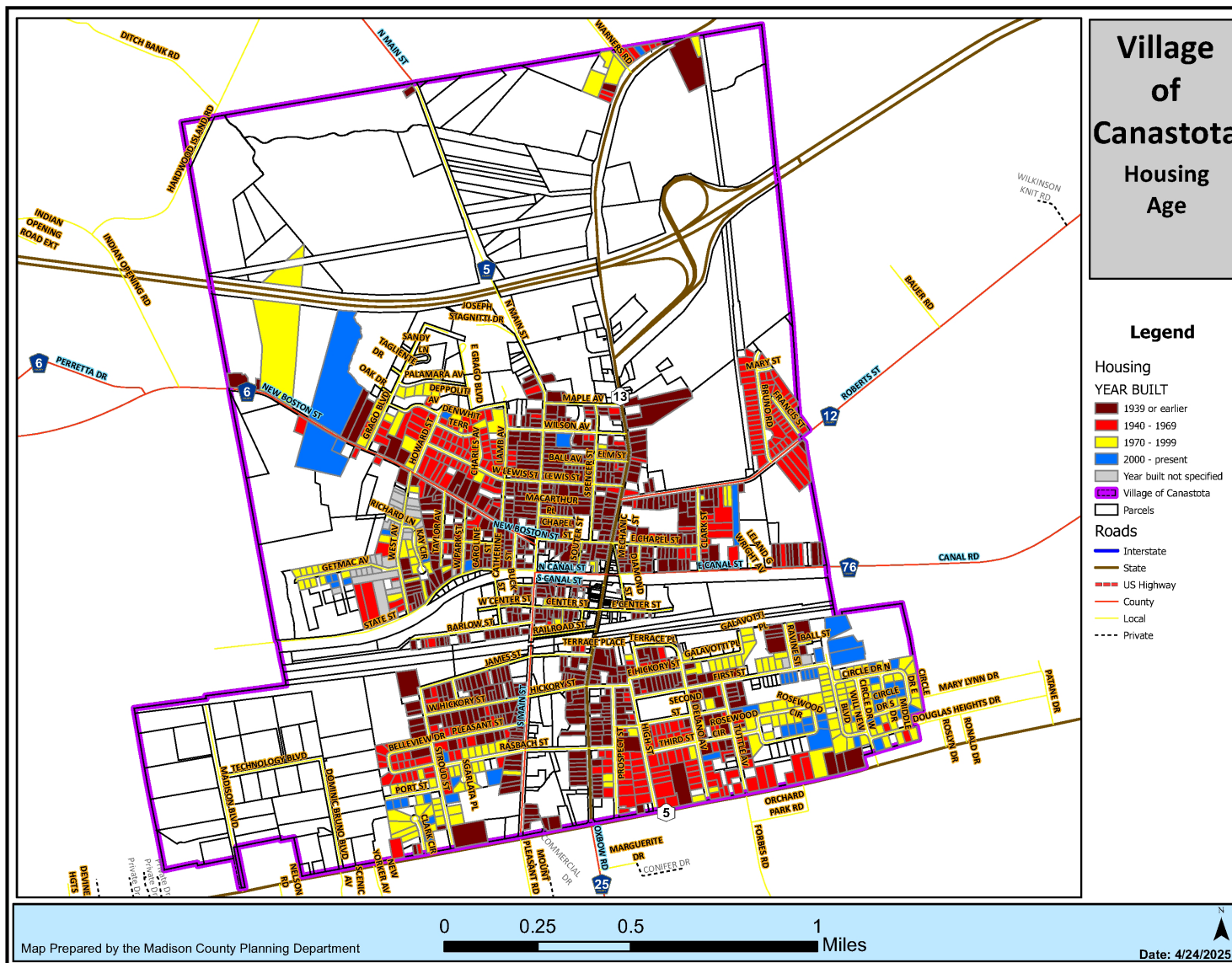
Canastota currently has 1,367 residential properties.

This map shows how housing has generally continued to build out around the core of downtown.

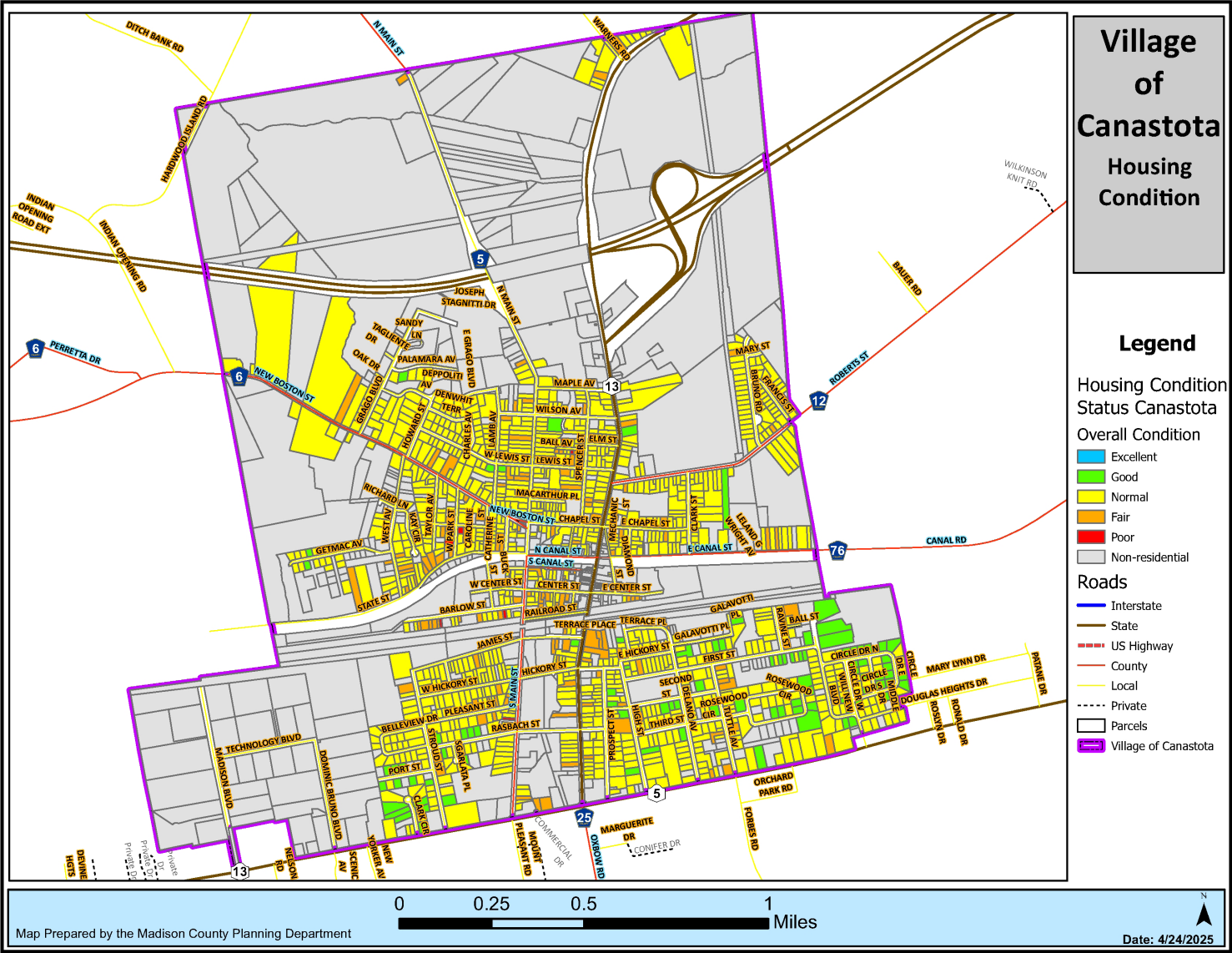

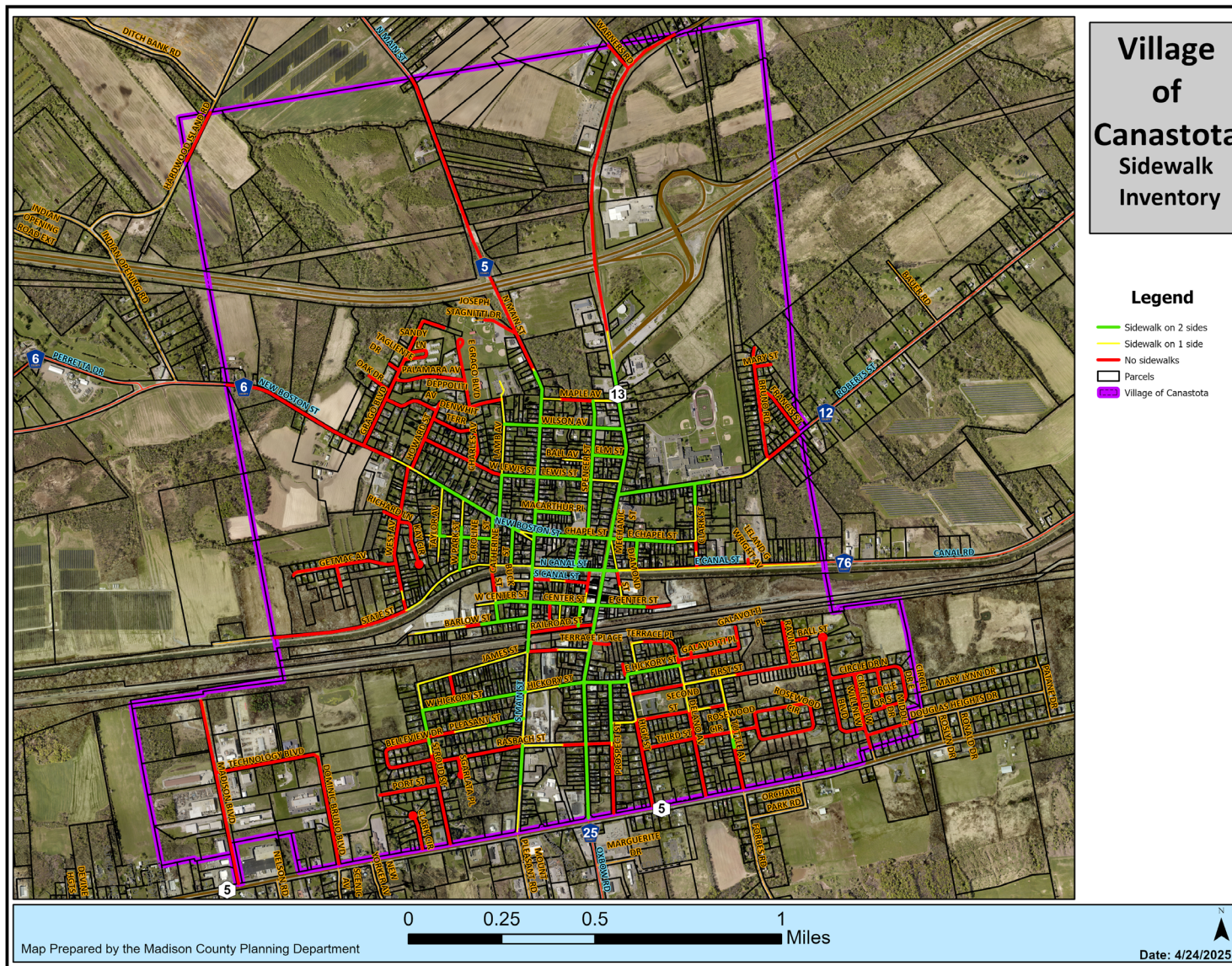

Most housing in the Village is currently categorized as "normal."





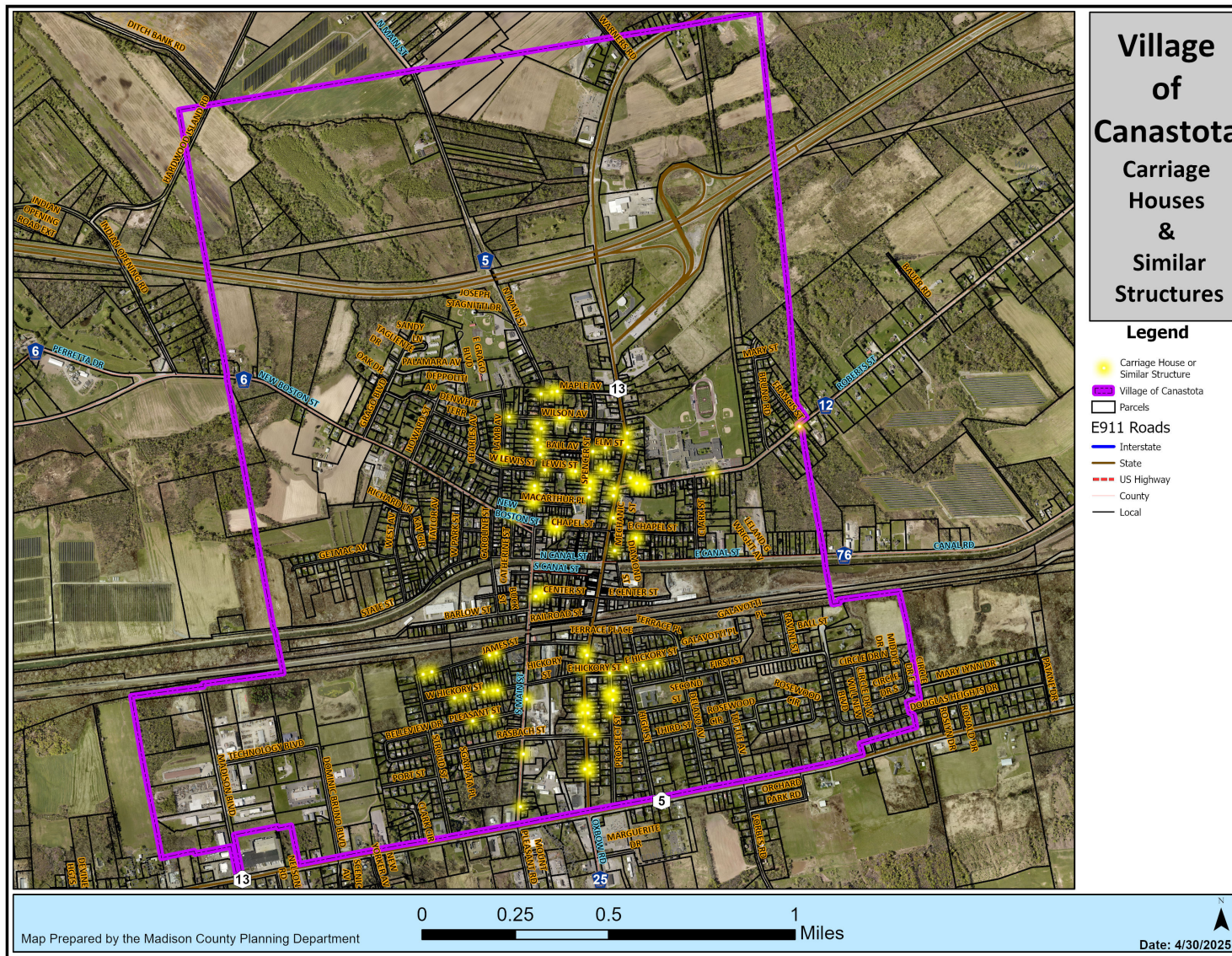
11. Sidewalk Inventory

This map shows where carriage houses, structures resembling carriage houses or barns, and large detached structures are located. These structures can serve as an Accessory Dwelling Unit (ADU).

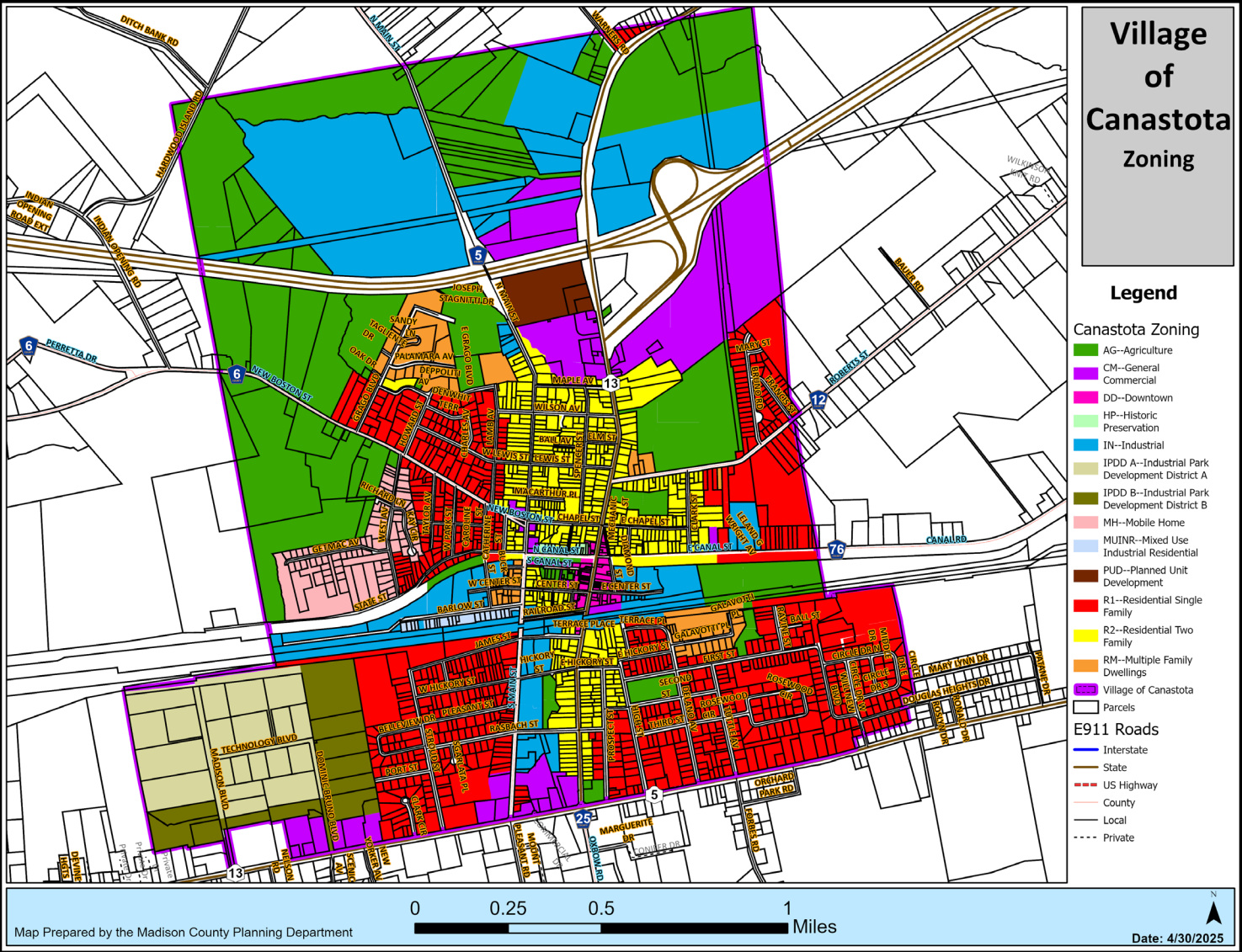
An ADU is a secondary structure, typically located at the rear of a lot, providing space for a small residential unit, home office, or other small commercial or service use.

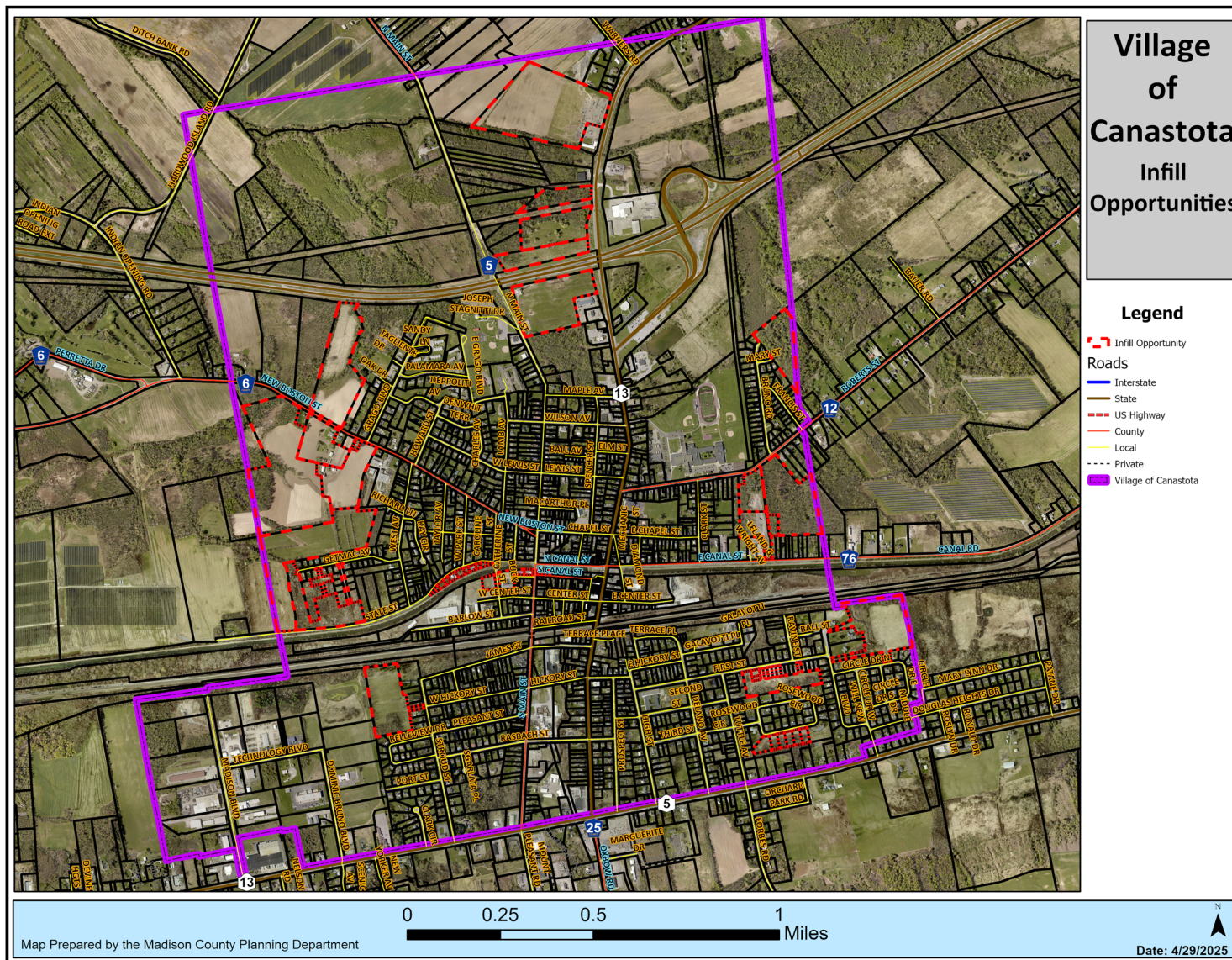

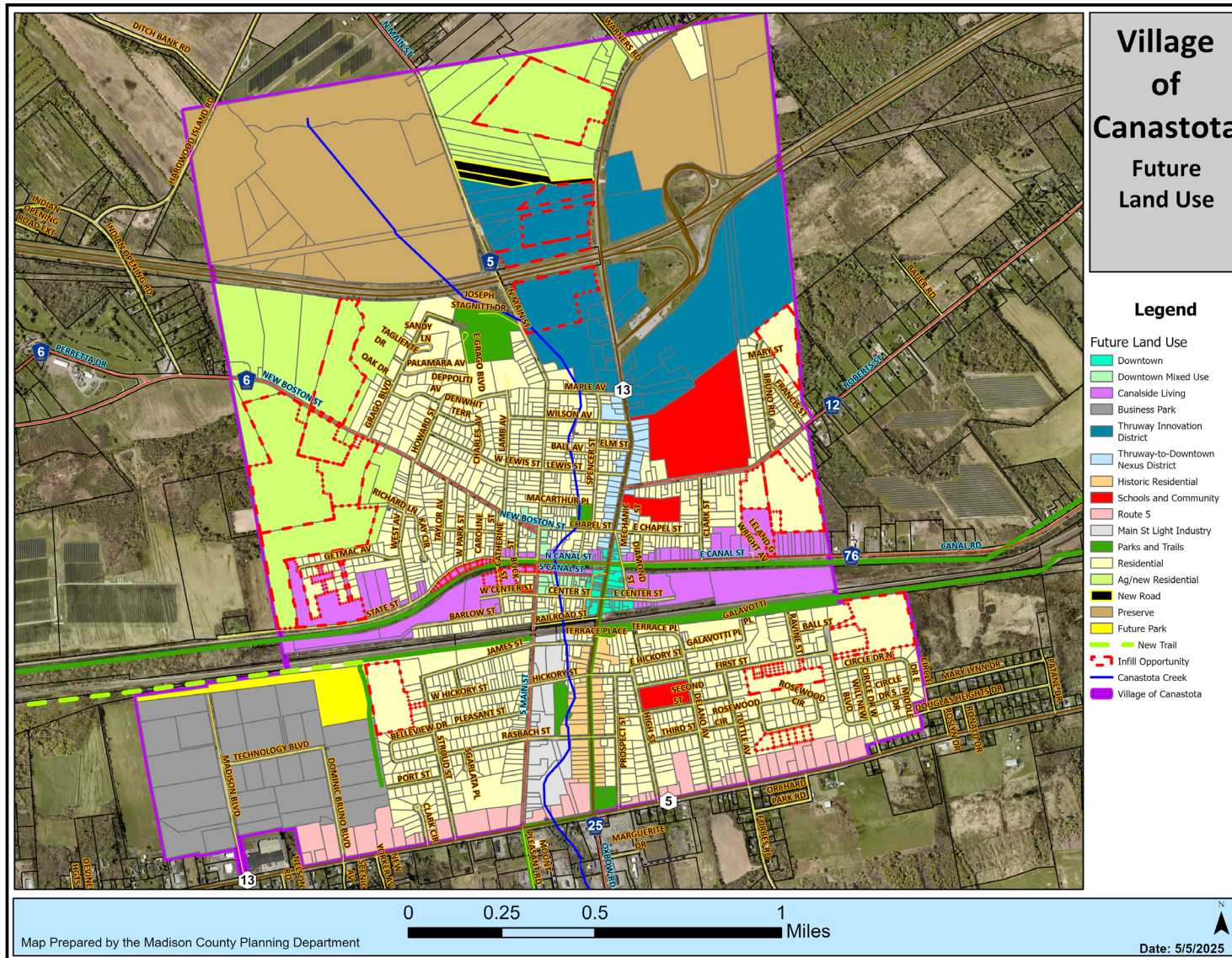
